Vineyard

Age of vines : 20 years old

grape variety :



75 % Cabernet Sauvignon



25 % Merlot



Cultivation

- Grassing controlled and every other row is ploughed
- Removing bad vine-branch by hand
- Trellising between wires by hand
- Mechanical leaf removal
- Phytosanitaires chemicals with economic and environmental approach: doses reduce at first of season (¼ doses), then half-doses (or ¾ doses if there is a high risk of disease)



Vinification

- Controls of analytical and taste maturities
- Mechanical harvest, at night if necessary to keep temperatures low.
- Skin maceration pre-fermentation 10 days
- Alcoholic fermentation
- Malolactic fermentation
- Filtration on land and bottling



Tasting

With its beautiful purple color, this Bordeaux Supérieur from Château Castenet has a powerful nose which develops aromas of black fruits. It's plump with ripe tannins and has a long finish. Serve chambered at 18°C with red meat or game, or with cheese. This is a wine to share with family or friends on hearty meals.
